

United States Small Business Administration's "2006 Financial Services Champion" Is A Special Breed Of Champion Indeed!

Washington, DC – Full time financial services executive, Woody Wollesen of Execunet, has been chosen to receive the coveted United States Small Business Administration "2006 Financial Services Champion" award at special ceremonies May 25, 2006, in the Ronald Reagan Building, Washington, DC. They are fully aware of Woody's ongoing achievements across a wide range of diverse endeavors. Self taught and beginning at age 58, Woody is a three time Maryland champion in Olympic discus and shot put, and silver medalist in javelin, competing in all three events for Maryland at the United States Senior Olympic Track & Field Championships, Pittsburgh, PA, in June 2005. Under the parameters and at his age, all were unprecedented accomplishments and “firsts”.
